Instructions before Capsule Endoscopy

- 1. Your test is scheduled for ______ at 8am.
- 2. Eat a regular breakfast and lunch the day before your test(______) Then start a clear liquid diet from 1 P.M. AVOID RED JELLO OR RED LIQUIDS.
- **3.** At 4 P.M on (______) Drink <u>HALF</u> gallon (2 liters) of <u>Nulvtley/Golvtely</u> over 2 hours drinking 8oz every 10-15 minutes. Take <u>two</u> tablets of <u>Gas-X</u> at 9-10 P.M
- **4.** From 12:00 midnight the evening before Capsule Endoscopy, do not eat or drink except for necessary medication with a sip of water.
- **5.** Do not take any medication beginning 2 hours before undergoing Capsule Endoscopy. Take your usual morning medication at 6 A.M
- 6. Abstain from smoking 24 hours before undergoing Capsule Endoscopy.
- 7. <u>**DO NOT**</u> take Iron Supplements, Motrin, Advil, Aleve, or any other Ibuprofen containing drugs for 7 days prior to your test.

Instructions the morning of Capsule Endoscopy

- 1. Arrive at your physician's office at the prescribed time for your Capsule Endoscopy dressed in loose fitting, two pieced clothing.
- 2. At your physician's office, you will have a pre-procedure interview. During this interview you should be informed that the Capsule Endoscopy is associated with a small chance of intestinal obstruction. You will be checked-in and asked to give your informed consent.
- 3. A Velcro belt will be place around your waist, and a purse-like pouch will be placed around your neck and shoulder. You will then be asked to swallow a vitamin-sized capsule. The capsule will pass naturally in your stool and may be safely flushed down the toilet.

Instructions during your Capsule Endoscopy

You have just swallowed a Capsule Endoscope. This sheet contains information about what to expect over the next 8 hours. Please call our office if you have severe or persistent abdominal or chest pain, fever, difficulty swallowing, or if you just have a question.

1. DO NOT EAT OR DRINK for 2 hours after swallowing the capsule.

2. After the first two hours you can then have <u>CLEAR LIQUIDS ONLY for the</u> <u>next 2 hours</u>.

- 3. After 4 hours you may have soups, crackers, toast and other light snacks until your test is completed.
- 4. After 2 P.M, you may eat or drink normally. You may take your medications at this time as well.
- 5. Look at the recorder every 30 minutes to see that the light is blinking. If not please call our office.
- 6. Do not exercise. Avoid heavy lifting. You may walk, sit, and lay down. You can drive a car. You can return to work. **Please avoid any activities that would require removal of the equipment you are wearing**.
- 7. Avoid going near MRI machines and radio transmitters. You may use a computer, radio, stereo, or cell phone. We advise that you avoid going to the bank, airport or government facilities during your test.
- 8. Do not stand directly next to another patient undergoing Capsule Endoscopy.

9. Do not touch the recorder or remove the equipment you are wearing.

- 10. Do not let water on the belt or the recorder. This is a very expensive equipment that could be damaged if not handled properly.
- 11. Return to the office at 4:15 PM for disconnection and removal of the equipment.
